We'd like to inform you that Councillors have approved an increase to marina fees in the 2019-20 Annual Plan. These fees take effect from 1 July 2019. Please refer to the table below which outlines the fee changes.

### Work completed and work scheduled for 2019/20

We have completed the repairs and painting of the Coene sheds, with the exception of replacing the rotten barge board and installation of a new flashing. This is part of our ongoing boat shed maintenance programme which commenced five years ago.

We have obtained resource consent to remove the slipway cradle, the rails and redundant timber piles. The slipway rails on the concrete apron and the winch will remain as heritage vestiges and we will install new lighting and interpretative panels. We also have designed and obtained building consent to adapt the small timber platform that leads from the boat harbour to the Freyberg Pool carpark, as this poses a significant health and safety risk. We are looking to commence works prior to Christmas 2019.

In other news, a recent change at the Council means that Kelly Crandle is the new Waterfront and City Parks Manager. The role includes management of the Evans Bay Marina and Clyde Quay Boat Harbour.
